

# INDONESIAN STANDARD CLASSIFICATION OF BUSINESS FIELD

Based on Article 1 Regulation of the Statistics Indonesia No. 2 of 2020 on Indonesian Standard Classification of Business Fields

Indonesian Standard Classification of Business Fields (KBLI) classifies Indonesian economic activities/actions that produce products/outputs, whether in the form of goods or services, based on the business fields used as standard references and tools for coordination, integration, and synchronization of statistical implementation.

Every Business Actors is required to select a KBLI code that accurately reflects their primary business activity.

### Why is KBLI Important?

- Determines what licenses and permits are required.
- Serves as the basis for assessing the risk level of business activities, which affects the business licensing process.
- Defines applicable legal obligations and technical standards.
- Influences the scope and legality of your business operations.

Choosing the correct KBLI is crucial, as it directly affects your company's legal compliance and operational scope.



## BUSINESS IDENTIFICATION NUMBER

Based on Article 1 (12) Government Regulation No. 5 of 2021 on the Organization of Risk-Based Business Licensing

Business Identification Number (NIB) is the proof of registration of Business Actors to carry out business activities and as an identity for Business Actors in carrying out their business activities.

#### How to Obtain an NIB

To obtain an NIB, Business Actors must first register through the Online Single Submission (OSS) system. The process involves:

- Determining the appropriate KBLI code(s) for your business activity.
- Creating an OSS account and submitting required company documents.
- Filling out business profile information, selecting risk levels, and uploading supporting documents.
- Once submitted and verified, the system will issue the NIB along with the KBLI code.

### Benefits of Having an NIB:

- Your business is officially recognized by the government.
- It is a key requirement for obtaining subsequent commercial or operational permits.
- Simplifies the licensing process and ensures data integration across government agencies.
